West Virginia Electric Auto Association (WVEAA) Activities

The WVEAA has promoted electric vehicles (EVs) in multiple ways:

- 1) We have presented EVs to the public at car shows, at EV show and drive events, and as slide show presentations to interested groups like churches, social groups, and green groups. Over the past five years, thousands of West Virginians have seen our presentations, sat in club member cars, and on some occasions, taken rides in member cars.
- 2) We have explained the impact of EVs on the economy and environment to state leaders and stakeholders. This has included a successful effort to convince the West Virginia Office of Energy and Department of Highways to devote part of the Volkswagen clean diesel settlement to fast DC charging stations at key locations around the state. We provided feedback to the WV Office of Energy for a technical paper they prepared on EV charging. We continue to press power companies and various government units to build charging infrastructure.
- 3) Several of our members have donated EV charging equipment to non-profit organizations. In 2019, one member donated a dual post charging station to the National Radio Observatory in Green Bank, West Virginia. The Observatory worked with the manufacturer to conduct radio interference testing on the equipment, then installed the station. Operating costs are paid by the EV drivers who visit the Observatory.
- 4) We have been and will continue to be a contact point for new and experienced EV drivers to interact and to socialize. This has included club meetings, weekend meetups, and dinners.
